

▶ Privacy Policy

This policy describes the types of information SeniorAdvocateOnline.com collects from you when you visit our site and how we use that information. Please read our policy carefully before providing personal information to us. Questions? Contact us.

Information We Collect

When you visit SeniorAdvocateOnline.com, Google Analytics tracks your IP address to determine if you are a unique visitor. We use Google Analytics to track usage statistics. If you reached our site by clicking on a link or advertisement on another site, Google Analytics tracks that information also. We aggregate this information to generate overall reports on site visitation that help us improve SeniorAdvocateOnline.com. We do not create reports about individual visitors. It is extremely difficult to identify you through your IP address, and we make no effort to do so.

We place small files known as "cookies" on your computer's hard drive. A cookie may contain information that allows us to track your path through our Website and to ascertain whether you have visited us before. Cookies cannot be used to read data off of your hard drive, and cannot retrieve information from any other cookies created by other Websites. We use cookies to help us improve our site and enhance your experience on SeniorAdvocateOnline.com. You may refuse to accept a cookie from us by following the procedures specific to your Internet browser.

How We Use Information We Collect

We may contact you with news or important information from SeniorAdvocateOnline.com, to provide you with other information or to request your feedback on our site. In addition to these periodic updates, we may email you additional materials, but only if you specifically request them. These might include opt-in newsletters and other materials that you request from SeniorAdvocateOnline.com.

If you have provided an email address, we may send you notifications about special offers or to tell you about opportunities available from our advertisers. You may opt-out of any or all marketing communications from SeniorAdvocateOnline.com.

Personal Information Disclosure

SeniorAdvocateOnline.com does not sell or rent any personal information to any third party. We may aggregate personal information from all of our users and provide that information to other parties, including advertisers, for marketing and promotional purposes, but they will not be able to identify you individually.

We also may share your personal information with third-parties we engage to provide services to SeniorAdvocateOnline.com. We require those parties to agree to use personally-identifiable data solely for the purpose of providing the specified services to SeniorAdvocateOnline.com.

SeniorAdvocateOnline.com must cooperate with legal authorities. In some circumstances we may be required to disclose personally identifiable information in response to requests from law enforcement authorities, or in response to a subpoena or other legal process. We don't expect this to happen, but if it does, we will provide only the information required. We can also disclose information about you if we believe we must in order to prevent a violation of the law, and by accepting this policy, you consent to our doing so, in our sole discretion. You also consent to our disclosing information about you in the course of legal proceedings if we are legally required to do so, if we reasonably believe that doing so may mitigate our liability, or if doing so will assist us in enforcing our legal rights. We also may share your information in connection with a corporate transaction, such as a divestiture, merger, consolidation, or asset sale, and in the unlikely event of bankruptcy.

SeniorAdvocateOnline.com will not share your email address nor display it any public manner.

Steps We Take To Protect Your Personal Information

SeniorAdvocateOnline.com security procedures protect the personal information stored in our systems. For example, we limit access to personal information about you to employees who we believe reasonably need to come into contact with that information. We also employ processes to protect against unauthorized access to your personal information. There is, however, no way for us to guarantee the absolute security of your personal information.
